## SITUATION IN MOMAAYO

IN THE CASE OF

BEFORE THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL COURT IN THE HAGUE

	Question	Answer
1.	The area of land the State of Momaayo sits on is mentioned to be 24,760 m² in the first paragraph of the moot problem, which is a considerably small region to accommodate 150,000 people. Could it have been 24,760 km²?	Correct, the statement of facts should state that the land mass of Momaayo is 24,760 km².
2.	Referring to paragraph 26 of the Moot Problem, are the 170 Momaayan men and boys who were killed include the villagers in the 3rd (third) sentence of paragraph 25 who were initially asked to sit along the side of the road?	No. The men and boys killed in paragraph 26 were brought into the street from their homes by the Kissakan soldiers.
3.	Does the reference to children in paragraph 26 of the question contain only girls?	Yes. The children refer to girls only.
4.	Did the murdered 170 men and boys mentioned in paragraph 26 carry spears, machetes or rolling pins like the villagers in Para.25 did?	Teams may assume that the further villagers who began exiting their homes to confront the Commando Battalion troops (paragraph 26, sentence 2) were also brandishing spears, machetes and rolling pins. This assumption does not extend to those villagers removed from their homes by the Kissakan forces (paragraph 26, sentence 4 onwards).
5.	What was the age of the boys forced into the street in paragraph 26?	"Boys" here means below the age of 18.
6.	In paragraph 29, did the Kissakan army filter crude oil into the Nadawada River in Momaayo's territory or in Kissaka's territory?	The Kissakan forces introduced the oil into the Nadawada River on the Kissakan side of the border.
7.	In paragraph 36, is the year of President Garba's order to return to Dunanti supposed to be 2021?	Yes. The facts should read, "At 8:30am on 5 October 2021, President Garba gave Lt. Col. Diallo the order to return to Dunanti to secure the oil access point"
8.	Are Momaayo and Kissaka the contracting parties to the 1976 Convention on the Prohibition of Military or any Hostile Use of Environmental Modification Techniques?	No. Neither Momaayo nor Kissaka is the contracting party to the 1976 Converntion.
9.	Are Momaayo and Kissaka the contracting parties Convention on the Safety of United Nations and Associated Personnel?	No. None of them are the contracting parties to the Convention on the Safety of United Nations and Associated Personnel.
10.	In the Annex II, we noticed the red line in the map, does that indicate the roads? If not, what does it mean?	Yes, the red lines on the Regional Map in Annex II indicate roads.
